

The human senses: A lesson plan in English

Language Level: B1

Interdisciplinary: ICT, Biology

Didactic Method: Task based learning, Pre-While-Post Listening

Materials: H/Y, Internet, worksheets, interactive board, cards

Class: B' class of Gymnasium-13 year old students

Time: 1hour

Main Goal: Practice on vocabulary concerning the five senses and different expressions with the word

"sense"

Skills: Listening, Speaking, Writing

Objectives:

- To consolidate and expand their vocabulary
- To understand spoken English in a song
- To be able to work in groups, cooperate and develop critical thinking
- To be able to select specific information from a Greek text and use it when giving advice in English

Lerning Scenario-Didactic Plan

Stage 1 Warm up - 10 mins

The students are divided in five groups, each belonging to one sense (sight, hearing, touch, smell, taste)

Group work: identification and drawing of the body organ related to each group on the group card

Questions related to the students' experience (given accordingly to each sense group):

SIGHT GROUP: What makes you happy when you see it?

HEARING GROUP: What's your favourite sound?

TOUCH GROUP: Which thing do you find pleasant to touch?

SMELL GROUP: What's your most pleasant smell?

TASTE GROUP: What do you find most delicious?

Present in plenary their answers and are asked: If you had to pick one sense...?

Stage 2- 20 mins

Listening task: Youtube video "the senses" http://www.youtube.com/watch?v=0UKI2-IOzC4

- Task 1: the students listen to the song two times in order to complete the missing words and a third time to confirm their answers
- In groups they do the exercises which help them practice vocabulary and pronunciation of similar words from the song

Stage 3- Mediation – 15 mins

Each group is given an online article from a Greek website (http://www.vita.gr/html/ent/586/ent.18586.asp) concerning the impairing of senses in the modern man and what people should do to train their senses. The groups are given the following task:

"Find in the article the part that is related to the sense of your group. Give advice to your friend about what he/she should do to improve this sense."

(Remember to use the special words and phrases we use to give advice.

A representative from a group presents the according output.

The students are assigned the following homework:

A. Imagine- a short story

Write a short story beginning: "One day I got up frightened after a terrible nightmare. As I got up and headed for the kitchen to drink some water, I realized that I couldn't.........

B. Find everyday phrases in English and Greek with the organs of the five senses
